



SKIN DIVERS' FLAG — William Ellis of 1708 North Fayette, left, explains the use of the diver's flag to Robert Endsley, 2621 Holland, and George B. Morley, 2532 North Woodbridge. Officially recognized by the State of Michigan, the flag indicates "diver below." Boats are required to keep 30 yards from the

site marked by the flag, which is red with a white diagonal stripe. Ellis, Endsley and Morley are members of Saginaw YMCA Underwater Explorers who urge all boat operators to recognize and respect divers' flags in the interest of safety. (Saginaw News Photo).
