## Film To Promote Water Safety

"Water World," an underwater film in color, will be presented at 7:30 p.m. Friday at Arthur Hill High School by the Saginaw Underwater Explorers Club.

Tickets cost 75 cents for children and adults. Proceeds will be used by the club to promote water safety.

The film was made by Stan Waterman, professional explorer and underwater photog-

rapher, during four years of work and exploration on the reefs and islands of the Bahamas. Some of the sequences show a battle with a giant, green moray eel; hand-feeding both gentle and dangerous reef fish; spear fishing in its classic form; descent into one of the mysterious Bahamian "blue holes"; and a water spout moving through Nassau Harbor, leaving a wake of destruction.
