## Col. Craig To Narrate Diving Film

Saginaw Underwater Explorers and the public will be escorted "Over and Under the Caribbean Sea" Saturday evening by Col. John D. Craig. He will narrate his all-color movie in the Saginaw group's sixth annual adventure presentation at 7:30 at Bridgeport High School.

Craig, noted television producer, will take his audience on a travelogue-treasure hunt to Grand Cayman, Haiti, the Virgin Islands and Bimini. Among scenes will be those of scuba divers filming Navy submarines, feeding sharks by hand and helping to recover \$7 million.

The explorers' club will display skin and scuba diving equipment, and members will give information on instruction, equipment and diving locations. The Saginaw group is one of the most active in the state. Its former president, Joseph Michaels, has just been elected president of the Michigan Skin Diving Council, succeeding George Morley, also a past head of the Saginaw group.

Three club members, Bruce A. Beckert, Dr. David E. Eagle and Robert Baillie, recently won state first-place awards in four of seven categories for underwater photography.
