Underwater Film, Lecture Planned Jan 20

Tickets are just going on sale for "Adventure on the Spanish Main," adventure tale told by Col. John D. Craig, returning for a second engagement under the auspices of Saginaw Underwater Explorers Club.

The lecture will be presented at 7:30 p.m. Jan. 20 at Bridgeport High School. Tickets are being made available at Saginaw Travel Service, 407 Court, or by mail from Saginaw Underwater Explorers, P.O. Box 1885, Saginaw.

Col. Craig will be here in person to narrate the high-adventure, all-color movie of an air-sea cruise over, across and under the Caribbean, following the trails of historic buccaneers on a modern age search for sunken treasure. The story and pictures will take the audience to the Bahama reefs, the Dry Tortugas, to historic Jamaica, the Florida keys and Haiti. The undersea portions will lead the Saginaw adventurers to virtual fairylands beneath tropical waters, and bring them into close contact with sharks, barracuda and scores of other fish.
