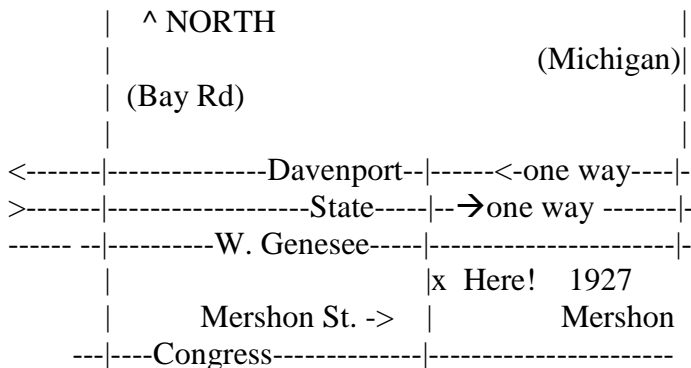

So who has time to read anymore anyway? I can honestly say that you will when you start reading *The Last Dive* by Bernie Chowdhery. If anyone gets the opportunity to pick this book up that hasn't read it, it is a great account of the father and son dive pair that lost their lives diving on an unknown U-Boat. The first couple of chapters explain a lot about diving and the effects on the body, and stories about the father son team that really bring you close to the pair. The rest of the book is sure to keep you up late reading as it describes their accomplishments and finally the fatal mistakes that lead to their deaths. There is a lot about the famous Andrea Doria, and North Atlantic wreck diving as well as some on the gin clear waters of Ginnie Springs, Florida. Sunrise Side Underwater Preserve
Informational Update

I had the privilege of attending a meeting just north of Tawas, MI with Matt Crews. The meeting was to determine what they were going to do about the Sunrise Side Underwater Preserve. A lot of good information was passed around. The group is recognized by the Federal Government who gave them the permit to buoy the Goshawk, and they cover the area from Alabaster to Black River. The group seemed to be very motivated and enthusiastic about the possibility of being a State recognized preserve. As of the meeting the small group has charted four new wrecks in an average of ten feet of water. One wreck is in 150 feet of water and several in over 200 feet of water. While at the meeting a drawing of one of the new wrecks was passed around and the group is very interested in the investigation and graphing of these new wrecks. They expressed interest in any help that they could get in research on the new wrecks found, and wreck hunting in that area. Right now they are operating with a 16 foot Zodiac and a plane. They are interested in anyone who wants to dive or has a boat that would like to take a weekend or two to help search in 2003. I know that I have talked to several people that are interested in this.
