Our compressor is due for an overhaul at 2000 hrs, which looks like 3 yrs away. Comp Chair Cunningham has contacted the Bauer Co. (maker) for an estimate, and they state about \$1000-1200 per cylinder. Ours is a 4-cyl, so we're looking at a possible \$4800 expenditure at that time.
