## **NEWS- SHIPWRECK PRESERVE MEETING**

At 6 pm on December 12, 2002, SUE members Matt Crews and Ron Burkhard attended a committee meeting of the Thumb Area Great Lakes State Bottomland Preserve held at the Road Commission building in Bad Axe, Mi. The primary purpose of the meeting was to determine the status of the Thumb preserve committee. However, many issues were discussed. Committee president Chris Roth was the only officer present. Steve Romzek, superintendent of Huron County Parks was present because the preserve is part of the county park system, the only one in the state with this status. Romzek is also an alternate voting member of the committee. Each preserve in the state has two votes on the Michigan Underwater Preserve Council. The Michigan Council will hold their next meeting on January 12, 2003 in St Ignace. It appeared that no voting member from the Thumb Preserve would be present at this meeting. This was the Thumb preserve's first meeting in 4 years.

One of the main concerns expressed during the meeting was the maintenance of the mooring lines on the shipwrecks. These mooring are maintained by volunteers. Burkhard volunteered to check with the Huron County Foundation on securing grant money to pay for mooring these shipwrecks. He will report at the next meeting, which is tentatively scheduled for April 2003.

Crews and Burkhard also attended the Sanilac Preserve meeting held in Port Sanilac on December 15, 2002. This was the Sanilac preserve's first meeting in 10 years. It was held to determine the status of the Sanilac preserve committee. Michigan Underwater Preserve Council President Mark Kistner was there and provided some information on the proposed sale of Michigan license plates featuring divers. Some of the money generated from the sale of these plates would go to the 11 underwater preserves in the state. He was trying to determine the status of the preserves and get them to attend the January meeting in St. Ignace.
