The Continuous Cycle of Tank Care

At the last two monthly club meetings, SUE was performing it's annual VIP of members' tanks. Not having a real big turnout either month, it would seem that either there is another option being used for VIPs, or the tanks are being neglected. Was it just last year that SUE voted to mandate annual VIPs to be in agreement with other clubs and shops?

Your editor's time was up this year to get his tanks hydro-tested, so it was full service. FYI, I took my tanks to Gale Fire Protection in Freeland for the hydros; they charged \$10/tank and have a turn-around time of a few days.

The subsequent VIP of the (steel) tanks found flash rust, due to the water fill of the hydro.

Club members should be aware that we have a tank tumbler at the compressor site just for this purpose. Steel shot is provided, and the tank can usually be cleaned up in about ½ hour or less. Ask the compressor operator that night.

Advice from the pro's-
After tumbling, you must get the tumbling material and dust out immediately. It has been suggested that the tank be flushed with a solution of cold water and dish detergent. The tank must then be dried. You might do this with flushing it with boiling water where the heat will dry it; or running a flow of hot air through it. Replace the valve, and fill it with dry air. Good luck on your season!
