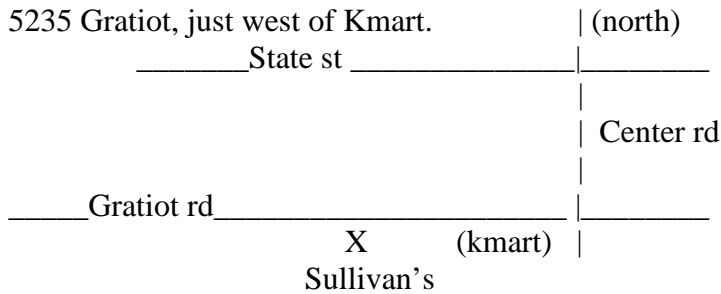

Coast Guard Divers

Back in August, two Coast Guard divers made a training dive in the Arctic; about 500mi north of Alaska. Lt. Jessica Hill, and Boatswain's Mate Steven Duque made an entry in a patch of open water off the icebreaker Healy. Both perished, in an as-yet unexplained accident. The original plan was to dive to 20ft, and they were to be controlled by tenders with ropes. For some unknown reason, both dropped quickly to a depth of 200ft, and by the time they were pulled up they were out of air and at least one of them had suffered pulmonary barotrauma(air expanding in the lungs due to pressure decrease on ascent). Attempts to resuscitate them failed. This autopsy was just released, but the investigation as to what happened is continuing. **RIP**
