Final '06 Dive Testimonial

The SCOOP could be wrong (although very infrequent), but this takes the award for the last dive a SUE member did in the year 2006. Due to the milder temps in December, Otter Lake has no ice and Charlie Storck decided to get one more dive in. Charlie did invite your editor along, but I had enough excuses ready to not get wet... here's Charlie's story-

I had two goals to achieve in this late year dive. Test my wet suit in cold water and try out my first nitrox mix. Brother Don agreed to go with me to Otter Lake but could not dive. So I added my first solo dive to the equation. Temps on the top side were about 50 F. Overcast day but good weather. I also wanted to try out my new under water camera. So the fun starts.

First dropping down at 5 ft to check gear, I lost my new camera. Well really did not, but gave me a scare. I did not have a weight attached and the camera floated up to my back side getting caught in my first stage. It was a relief to see it was still attached and just tangled up. After attaching camera to another point I took a compass

reading and headed down toward the boat.

After what I thought was a long enough swim to get to the boat I was concerned that I had missed my mark. No boat to be seen. So I decided to come back to surface to check bearings. To my surprise I rose just shy a few feet of the buoy. So I dropped back down and settled right next to the side of the boat. Visibility was very bad. If I would have given another kick down under I would have hit it. There did not seem to be much algae but still it was black as night. I tried to get pictures of the boat but the camera did not have enough light to even lock on to. I did not take my external light so all I had was my little backup on the BC. Still not enough! So I scrubbed the camera idea and went on to just enjoy the dive and test out my nitrox mix and suit. I found the rope going down and started down to a deeper depth. Did I say it was black as night? I could hardly even see my gauges even with illumination. I followed the rope down to a little over forty feet. At that point I saw absolutely nothing and decided to abort going any deeper.

I cannot say why it was so dark. I came back to the boat and close to the bottom to check out conditions. Lots of silt but I am still feeling my way around.

Well I took a couple of spins around the area close to the bottom and then finished with about 20 minutes under. It was a great dive for me in spite of the lack of seeing anything.

It was 39 degrees F below and my suit kept me in my comfort zone. My final comment is that using the 36% Nitrox left me with more energy coming out.

The change was noticeable. All things considered it was a good dive for my goals. Oh, did I mention it was black as night?!
