USS EDSON; coming to Bay City?

Retired Destroyer Displayed in Bay City?

The Saginaw Valley Naval Ship Museum is hoping they get the nod for donation of the destroyer by the U.S. Navy. Richard J. Janke, VP of the SVNSM, stated it submitted a 1615-page application, three years in the making, to the Navy last week. Clifford C. Van Dyke of the Bay County growth alliance, is looking at this as a big economic benefit from tourism. The ship museum must front the fuel cost of towing the ship here from Philadelphia, and also prepare a dock site for her. Contributions have been coming in from major benefactors; more are needed.

USS Edson (DD-946) was a Forrest Sherman-class destroyer named for Colonel Merritt "Red Mike" Edson USMC who was awarded the Medal of Honor while serving as Commanding Officer of the First Marine Raider Battalion.

The Edson was launched 4 January 1958 by Bath Iron Works Corp., and commissioned 7 November 1958 (note SUE beginnings!)

The reader should also be aware of the competition; WINSA (Wisconsin Naval Ship Association) of Sheboygan, Wisconsin has also submitted an application to the Naval Sea Systems Command, to relocate the ship and reinstate it as a museum ship in Sheboygan. WINSA has now completed two of the three major task required to attain the Edson. They still must raise the funds required to finance the project and bring the Edson permanently to Sheboygan

WINSA submitted it's application to the navy office on Dec 26, beating the Jan 3 deadline. The Navy is expected to announce its decision in the spring of 2008.

Diving the Straits Underwater Preserve, Michigan, USA =====

“It is illegal to remove or disturb artifacts in the Great Lakes of Michigan, which means that small items like cups, tools, silverware and ornaments often remain where they were discovered by the first divers many years before. Diving the Straits Underwater Preserve is not for the "faint of heart" especially if you are wearing a wetsuit (as I was). The temperature drops to 41 degrees F below the thermocline, but the views of well preserved shipwrecks is worth the shivering. My favourite is the Eber Ward, century old wreck in 120 feet of water. This ship was sunk in 1909 after encountering packs of ice on its first journey of the season, leaving holes in the bow large enough to swim through. There are entrances at the stern as well, and once inside you can swim from one end to the other entirely inside on not one but two decks. The upper one is the more interesting, with rows of hand carts towards the bow, and well-preserved loading gear hanging under every cargo hatch. Two large, hinged anchors are still inside the bow, and another rest just below on the lake bottom. One of the strangest items to find was a capstan inside the wreck. The not-to-be-missed items on this wreck include the prop, bathtub, and ultra-rare mushroom anchor which is still in place in the hawse pipe on the port side. Of the 700 or so dives that I've done around the world since 1975, this is my favourite.”
