To help speed the process this month, bleed that old air out of your tanks, and have your air card at the ready. Check and make sure your tank is currently hydro'd; the SCOOP suggests a quick trip to Gale Fire Protection in Freeland if not...

Along with that thought, plan ahead to the June meeting, when Scott (Gale Fire Protection), will speak at the meeting in reference to hydros and eddy current tests on aluminum tanks (see following notice). There was no critical business conducted last month, and none is expected this month.
