New Dive Shop

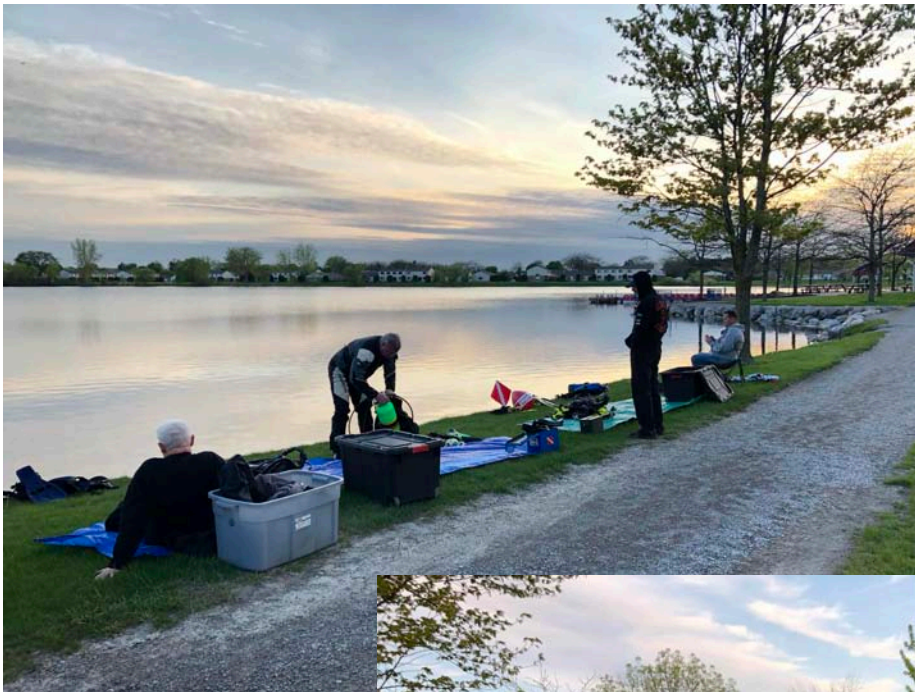
